## Measurements

Basic Black for card base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored @ 4 1/4"

Calypso Coral: 3 3/4" x 5" Basic Black: 3 ½" x 5" Die Cut

Basic White:  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" Mixed Media DSP:  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" Basic White:  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 5

- 1. Cut and score all measurements.
- 2. Use Bone Folder to burnish fold.
- 3. Run Calypso Coral through with Plaster 3D Embossing Folder.
- 4. Attach Calypso Coral to card base.
- 5. Cut out large sprig in Basic Black. Attach to Calypso Coral.
- 6. Stamp Tulip Image with Memento Ink.
- 7. Colour image with Blends: Calypso Coral, Old Olive, Pool Party
- 8. Die cut image.
- 9. Stamp 3 tulips with Memento Ink onto DSP. Fussy Cut.
- 10. Attach cut out images to colored image.
- 11. Attach image to card base with dimensionals.
- 12. Stamp sentiment with versamark onto black strip.
- 13. Heat set with White Embossing Powder.
- 14. Attach Sentiment with Dimensionals.
- 15. On inside White, stamp smaller image and color.
- 16. Attach to inside.
- 17. Embellish with gems

- 1. Stamp the flowers, banner and words on Basic White Scrap Paper.
- 2. Color the flowers with Stampin' Blends Markers.
- 3. Using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine:
- 4. Die cut the flowers and Banner
- 5. Die cut the foliage in Basic White
- 6. Emboss the background with the Plaster Painting Folder
- 7. Assemble the card with Seal Adhesive & Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Attach Low Profile Dots

Inside Card

Basic White - 4" x 5 1/4"

- 1. Adhere coordinating DSP strip on center of DSP layer with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere to card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 2. Die cut square with Basic White scrap using Stylish Shapes Dies (2nd largest).
- 3. On die cut square, stamp leaf image from Textured Notes Stamp Set, in lower right corner with Garden Green ink (2nd generation).
- 4. Fussy cut flower image from Lovely Garden DSP.
- 5. Loop Linen Thread twice around three fingers and adhere behind fussy cut floral image.
- 6. Adhere floral image in lower right corner of die cut square with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Embellish your card with Iridescent Faceted Gems.
- 8. Inside Card:
  - a. On Basic White, stamp leaves in lower left with Garden Green ink (2nd generation).
  - b. Fussy cut a smaller flower from DSP. Adhere in lower corner with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
  - c. Adhere Basic White inside card.

Highland Heather ~ 3 1/4" 2 1/2" ~ Nested Essential Panel

Basic White ~ 23/4" x 2" ~ emboss with Happy Hibiscus

Basic White scrap for Sentiment

- 1. Emboss Basic White Panel with Exposed Brick, adhere to Card Base
- 2. Emboss a Basic White Panel using Happy Hibiscus, using Blending Brushes, blend various inks on the Debossed Side (see Video)
- 3. Die cut all the elements needed for the card ~ Butterflies, Nested Essentials various styles (see picture or Video)

Basic Beige Card Base 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", scored at 4 1/4" Pebbled Path Mat Mat 4" x 5 1/4" Timeless Plaid DSP 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" Scraps of Basic Beige and Pebbled Path Cardstock

- 1. Adhere card base, mat and Designer Series Paper.
- 2. Cut cardstock scraps with frame dies mix and match different colors for inside and frame pieces to maximize your time and paper for multiple cards.
- 3. Stamp inside pieces with a scene or a sentiment or just leave blank. Color images if desired. Adhere to card.
- 4. With Dimensionals add a die cut or fussy cut image from the Storybook Designer Paper.
- 5. Add pearls, bow and/or a stamped sentiment.

#### Measurements

Boho Blue cardbase - 5-1/2" X 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"

Basic White cardstock layer - 4" X 5-1/4"

Boho Blue partial Arch - 2-½" X 4-5%" (partial of 3rd largest Arch)

Basic White partial Arch - 2-3/8" X 4-1/4" (partial of 4th largest Arch)

Night of Navy sentiment - 1" X 3-1/2"

Basic White cardstock - 4" X 5-1/4" (inside)

- 1. Use Boho Blue Ink to stamp Painted Stripes across one of the Basic Whote layers. Glue both Basic White layers to the card base stripes on front, plain inside.
- 2. Use Night of Navy Ink to stamp sentiment on the partial arch.
- 3. Use Memento Black Ink to stamp the cupcake below the sentiment. Colour as desired.
- 4. Wipe the whole image with the embossing buddy. Stamp candle sparks using Versamark ink and heat emboss with gold.
- 5. Attach the partial white arch to the partial Boho Blue arch. Trim any excess.
- 6. Attach the arches to the card front using Dimensionals line up with the edge of the striped layer.
- 7. Tie a bow of Twisted Gold Thread and attach to the lower left of the arch with a mini glue dot.
- 8. Stamp sentiment on Night of Navy carstock using Versamark. Heat emboss in white.
- 9. Fussy cut the sentiment and attach to the card front with a Dimensional on the left and glue on the right.
- 10. Embellish with Textured Dots.

#### Measurements

Pool Party Card Base: 4-1/4" x 8-1/4" (10.5 x 20.5 cm)

White Flap Layer: 2-1/2" x 4" (7.0 x 10.0 cm) Vellum Flap Layer: 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" (7.5 x 11.3 cm) Pool Party Layer 2: 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" (7.5 x 9.0 cm) White Layer 2: 2-1/2" x 3-1/4" (7.0 x 8.5 cm) White Inside Layer: 4" x 5-1/4" (10.0 x 14.3 cm) Floral Inside Layer: 3-3/4" x 5" (7.5 x 11.3 cm)

Small White Inside Layer: 2-1/2" x 3-1/4" (7.0 x 8.5 cm)

- 1. Score Pool Party card base at 5-1/2" (14.8 cm)
- 2. Layer floral vellum DSP onto large white cardstock. Adhere to inside of card.
- 3. Layer checkered vellum DSP onto white cardstock.
- 4. Wrap ribbon around left edge of gingham layer; tie bow or knot. Attach mini glue dot under knot/bow to anchor in place. Adhere to front flap of card base.
- 5. Stamp sentiment in upper right corner of 2-1/2" x 3-1/4" white cardstock using Pool Party ink.
- 6. Create floral image: Stamp stem (Garden Green), leaves (Garden Green) and flowers (Lemon Lolly & Daffodil Delight).
- 7. Attach stamped white to Pool Party cardstock. Adhere to card front flap making sure to only apply adhesive to left side.
- 8. Stamp inside sentiment on 2-1/2" x 3-1/4" white cardstock using Pool Party ink. Attach to inside of card making sure it's hidden under the card front 'flap'.
- 9. Embellish card front with Tiny Bee Trinket.

Basic White Thick Card 10 x 3" (match book) Scrap (die cutting)

Lovely Garden DSP 3 1/4 x 2 7/8" (layer) 3/4 x 2 7/8" (layer)

Melon Mambo Card Scrap (die cutting)

Daffodil Delight Card Scrap ( die cutting )


Fresh Freesia Scrap (die cutting)

- 1. Score and burnish Basic White Thick card on 10" side @ 1, 5 1/2, 5 3/4".
- 2. Staple the 1" scoreline about 1/4" from the scoreline (this is the closure of the treat holder, where the opposite edge will fold under)
- 3. Adhere the two DSP pieces to front of treat holder with adhesive.
- 4. Die cut letters to form EASTER from dies.
- 5. Die cut the bee wings to form the bunny wings from Basic White Thick card.
- 6. Die cut flowers from Daffodil Delight, Melon Mambo & Fresh Freesia card (you will need 4)
- 7. Place dimensionals on rabbit ears and adhere to treat,.
- 8. Tie a bow from the Daffodil Delight ribbon and adhere to bunny ears with a Mini Glue Dot.
- 9. Place dimensionals on flowers and adhere to treat holder.
- 10. Place a Basic Rhinestone in every flower centre.
- 11. Colour sentiment and flowers with Wink Of Stella.
- 12. Adhere treat inside holder with Tear N Tape.

#### Measurements

Card base - Thick Basic White - 29.7 x 10.5cm or 11 x 4 1/4 inches

Layer One - Basic White -  $14.3 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  or  $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 4 \text{ inches}$ 

Under layer - Thoughtful Journey DSP - 14 x 9.7 cm or 5 x 3 3/4 inches

- 1. Score base card at 14.85cm, fold and crisp with bone folder
- 2. Position lattice die from Linked Together dies onto Basic White card piece. Ensure it is equal distance from top, bottom and side edges. Die cut using die cutting machine.
- 3. Using Dimensionals, adhere the patterned paper piece to the back of the Basic White layer.
- 4. Add adhesive of choice to back of lattice die cut and position in cavity from where it was die cut and adhere to patterned paper.
- 5. Die cut two long leafy vine pieces, one from Old Olive scrap and one from Mossy Meadow scrap. Die cut one of the shorter leafy vine pieces from Garden Green scrap.
- 6. Using Mini Glue dots adhere the vine pieces as per photo, tucking ends under the frame edge.
- 7. Stamp "Wishing You" in Old Olive onto scrap Basic White, fussy cut, add Dimensionals to back and position on card front.
- 8. Stamp "a happy day" in Petunia Pop, fussy cut, add Dimensionals to back and position on card front.
- 9. Add three white sequins to complete the card.

#### Measurements

Old Olive Cardstock - 14.85cm x 21cm

Basic Beige Cardstock - 14.45cm x 10.1cm

Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper (brown) - 13.5cm x 5cm

Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper (blue) - 7.5cm x 9.5cm

Basic Beige Cardstock - 6cm x 9.5cm

Basic Beige Cardstock - 8.5cm x 3cm

Basic Beige Cardstock - 5cm x 14.85cm

Crumb Cake Cardstock - 6cm x 1.3cm

- 1. Cut Old Olive Cardstock into a 14.85cm x 21cm piece. Score and fold at 10.5cm.
- 2. Cut Basic Beige Cardstock into a 14.45cm x 10.1cm piece. Emboss using the Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder.
- 3. Using Paper Snips Scissors, scrape the blades along the edges of the embossed Basic Beige Cardstock to distress them. Adhere to the folded card base using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 4. Cut Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper (brown) into a 13.5cm x 5cm piece. Tear along the top and bottom edges.
- 5. Wrap a 15.5cm piece of Basic Beige Bordered Ribbon along the brown plaid paper and secure at the back using Mini Glue Dots. Thread a 10cm piece of Basic Beige Bordered Ribbon under strip of ribbon and tie around it in a knot.
- 6. Adhere the brown plaid paper to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 7. Cut Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper (blue) into a 7.5cm x 9.5cm piece. Using Paper Snips Scissors, scrape the blades along the edges to distress them.
- 8. Adhere the blue paid paper to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Die cut a Storybook Friends arch from a 6cm x 9.5cm piece of Basic Beige Cardstock. Adhere to the blue plaid paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 10. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp the grassy hill onto an 8.5cm x 3cm piece of Basic Beige Cardstock. Colour using the following Stampin' Blends: Old Olive (combo) and Calypso Coral (dark).
- 11. Using Paper Snips Scissors, fussy cut around the grassy hill, leaving a straight edge along the bottom. Adhere along the bottom of the blue plaid paper using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 12. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp two bunnies onto a 5cm x 14.85cm piece of Basic Beige Cardstock. Colour using the following Stampin Blends: Crumb Cake (light), SU 500, Old Olive (combo), Boho Blue (combo) and Calypso Coral (combo).
- 13. Die cut the bunnies using their coordinating Storybook Friends dies. Adhere to the card, using Multipurpose Liquid
- 14. Glue behind their feet and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals behind their upper half.
- 15. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp the sentiment into the centre of a 6cm x 1.3cm piece of Crumb Cake Cardstock.
- 16. Trim the ends on an angle. Adhere to the card using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 17. Embellish using Antique Pearls.

- 1. Cut and score cardstock as per measurements.
- 2. Fold card base on scorelines in mountain/mountain configuration. Burnish with Bone Folder.
- 3. Colour Basic White cardstock using Fresh Freesia Stampin' Blends in stripes with Light alternating with Dark.
- 4. Use Color Lifter Stampin' Blend along seam of light and dark stripes
- 5. Spritz with water using Stampin' Spritzer
- 6. Splatter with Wink of Stella
- 7. Cut using 3rd largest Textured Notes Die save pieces that are trimmed off
- 8. Stamp flower image on die cut.
- 9. Adhere to Basic Black cardstock
- 10. Adhere to the bottom flap of the card base.
- 11. Adhere embelilshments
- 12. Tie a bow from White ribbon and adhere to card base using Glue Dot.
- 13. Cut a 3/4" x 5 1/4" (1.8 cm x 14.4 cm) piece from the coloured Basic White (this is the piece that was die cut)
- 14. Adhere to the right side of the card.
- 15. Adhere to the inside of the card
- 16. Stamp sentiment on Basic White cardstock
- 17. Adhere to Basic Black cardstock using Dimensionals
- 18. Adhere to the inside of the card using Dimensionals at the bottom this will hold the easel open

For Stamping (Basic White): 1-1/2" x 2-3/4"

For Mini Alphabet Die Cuts (Early Espresso): scraps

For Sentiment (Basic Beige): scrap

- 1. Stamp the Elements of Text script in Basic Beige ink on Layer 2
- 2. Stamp the Delightful Wishes flowers in Peach Pie (for the outline) & Daffodil Delight (for the filler)
- 3. Stamp the splatter in 1st & 2nd Generation Pecan Pie ink
- 4. Stamp the 'BIRTHDAY' sentiment from Delightful Wishes in Memento ink on Basic Beige scrap then trim with Paper Snips
- 5. Stamp the Storybook Friends bunny in Memento ink on Basic White card
- 6. Colour with Stampin' Blends: Crumb Cake, Pecan Pie, Boho Blue and Deep Combo
- 7. Die cut the bunny with coordinating die and 'HOPPY' from the Mini Alphabet in Early Espresso scraps
- 8. Adhere all layers and the 'HOPPY' letters FLAT on the Crumb Cake cardbase
- 9. Add the coloured bunny and 'BIRTHDAY' sentimnet with Stampin' Dimensionals
- 10. Embellish with 3 Garden Green Dots For Days
- 11. Finish by adding highlights to the 'HOPPY' letters using a white gel pen

- 3. Diecut your images and decorate your card.

# Floral Birthday Wishes

#### Measurements

Card base (Peach Pie)  $14.9 \times 21.0 \text{ cm}$  (5  $1/2 \times 8 \cdot 1/2$ ") Embossed layer and insert (Basic White) 2 pieces  $14.4 \times 10.0 \text{ cm}$  (5  $1/4 \times 4$ ") Octagon background (Basic White)  $8.0 \times 8.0 \text{ cm}$  (3  $1/2 \times 3 \cdot 1/2$ ") Scraps of Basic White, Peach Pie and Lost Lagoon for die cuts

- 1. Cut the card stock to the above measurements.
- 2. Die cut the floral octagon in the centre of one of the Basic White pieces.
- 3. Use a blending brush to apply some Peach Pie ink to the embossing folder. Run the layer through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
- 4. Stamp the floral image onto a scrap of Basic White and onto the bottom right corner of the insert with Memento ink.
- 5. Colour the image with Stampin' Blends.
- 6. Stick the insert inside the card.
- 7. Die cut the image on the scrap card stock.
- 8. Die cut two Peach Pie and two Lost Lagoon leaves.
- 9. Die cut the background wishing in Peach Pie and the overlay in Lost Lagoon (apply Adhesive Sheet to the Lost Lagoon before you cut it to make it easy to stick in place)
- 10. Blend Peach Pie ink onto the Basic White square.
- 11. Apply adhesive to the edges of the square and stick it behind the die cut octagon.
- 12. Stick the layer onto the front of the card.
- 13. Cut the leaves shorther and stick them onto the front of the card.
- 14. Stick the die cut flowers over the join of the leaves with a Stampin' Dimensional.
- 15. Stick the "wishing" onto the top of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 16. Stamp the birthday greeting onto a scrap of Basic White with Lost Lagoon ink. Die cut with the strip die.
- 17. Stick it onto the bottom of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 18. Decorate with the Rainbow Dots.

Card Base Fresh Freesia 4-1/4" x 11" scored at 5-1/2" and 2-3/4"

Layer 1 Fresh Freesia 2-1/2" x 4"

Layer 2 Basic Black 3-3/4" x 5" (2)

Layer 3 Basic White 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" (2)

Layer 4 Basic White 1-1/2" x 3"

Layer 5 Garden Green 2-1/2" x 2-3/4"

- 1. Fold the card base in half at 5-1/2" and back at 2-3/4" to make a z-fold card base.
- 2. Place layer 1 Fresh Freesia card stock in the Mini Corrugated Embossing Folder and run through a die cutting machine. Attach to the front of the card.
- 3. Attach Basic White card stock to Basic Black card stock and then to the inside of the card.
- 4. Die cut a leaf from Garden Green card stock and attach to the inside of the card.
- 5. Stamp the flower image with Black Memento ink on Basic White card stock.
- 6. Grab some scratch paper or grid paper. Place Thankful Garden Mask 1 over the image. Make a pencil mark on the v notch on the mask. This is how you line up the masks. Using a blending brush, apply Bubble Bath ink to the flower.
- 7. Place Thankful Garden Mask 2 over the image, lining up the notch. Using a blending brush, apply Fresh Freesia ink to the flower.
- 8. Place Thankful Garden Mask 3 over the image, lining up the notch. Using a blending brush, apply Fresh Freesia ink to the flower.
- 9. Place Thankful Garden Mask 4 over the image, lining up the notch. Using a blending brush, apply Soft Seafoam ink to the leaves and stem.
- 10. Place Thankful Garden Mask 5 over the image, lining up the notch. Using a blending brush, apply Garden Green ink to the leaves and stem.
- 11. Attach this layer to Basic Black card stock.
- 12. Attach to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals placed on the left hand side of the card stock and lining up with the inside of the card.
- 13. Die cut a rectangle shape from Basic White card stock using the Textured Notes Dies.
- 14. Stamp the sentiment with Black ink and attach to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 15. Tie a bow using the Faux Velvet ribbon. Attach to the card using a Glue Dot.
- 16. Add three sequins to the card front.

- 1. Fold the Blueberry Bushel card base in half.
- 2. Adhere the Crushed Curry Layer to the card front.
- 3. Mask off the edges of the white layer (use making paper or tape, or just paper) and then use a blending brush with just a little bit of blue ink to create a soft blue background.
- 4. While the masking is still in place, stamp the bubble image randomly around. You can stamp off first for a softer effect.
- 5. Remove masking and adhere the white layer to the card front.
- 6. Stamp the turtle in Garden Green ink. Use full strength for the detailed side and then half strength (stamping off) for the reverse side to fill in the turtle.
- 7. Do the same technique with the Crushed Curry ink and the Star Fish stamps.
- 8. Fussy cut the turtle and star fish then add to the card using Dimensional adhesives.
- 9. Stamp a greeting of your choice on a little strip of white card stock. Add to card, along with some iridescent pearls.

- 8. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the Nested Essentials Banner Die the card front over the floral die-cuts. Use photos for placement if needed.
- 9. color the teacup using Blended Pens and Pretty Peacock Ink as shown in photos.
- 10. Adhere the fussy-cut tea cup and 'Thanks' sentiment to the Banner die-cut as shown in photos.
- 11. Tie a bow with Gold cording and adhere to the banner die-cut with Mini Glue Dots.
- 12. Lastly, using Gold-Textured Adhesive Backed Dots, embellish the card as you wish.

- 8. Place a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " square  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " from the left edge of the  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" cardstock so  $\frac{1}{4}$ "  $\frac{1}{2}$ " of the point goes off the edge. (diamond shape)
- 9. Place the next square below and to the left of the first square.
- 10. Place the next square down and to the right of the second square.
- 11. Continue going back and forth from left to right with the squares. The last square should end up going off the bottom left edge of the  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" cardstock.
- 12. Trim the edges off the last square and use the piece you cut off to fill in at the very top above and to the left of the first square you placed.

- 3. Cut the Wild Wheat base down the middle at 2 1/8"
- 4. Now cut those pieces at 3.25" so you have four pieces of wild wheat
- 5. Now take the DSP and cut it down the middle at 17/8"
- 6. Now the top 1/2 should be cut so you have 3" and 2" pieces, and the bottom half should be cut so that you have 2" and 3" pieces. This is so they fit back together design-wise.
- 7. Attach the DSP to the wild wheat to recreate your card front
- 8. Now attach the completed base/dsp pieces to the edges of the base making sure you only have adhesive on the outer 1" of the pieces you are adhering.
- 9. When attached the front should close tightly and appear as though it is a full card front.
- 10. Stamp the sentiment onto a scrap of basic white
- 11. Use the die or the punch from the bundle to cut out and attach to the card using dimensionals
- 12. I stamped a butterfly from another scrap and fussy cut it out and attached using dimensionals.



- 5. Die cut the larger outside die from Memorable Blooms in Basic White cardstock. Remove the inner octagon shape and stamp the large flower from Memorable Blooms on this piece in Lost Lagoon ink.
- 6. Die cut the large detailed die from Memorable Blooms in Lost Lagoon cardstock and then adhere this piece to the previous stamped octagon piece with liquid glue. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- 7. Stamp and die cut two of the smaller flower images. Colour using Stampin' Blends. Adhere to the card front with Dimensionals.
- 8. Stamp the greeting Memento and fussy cut out. Add to card front with mini dimensionals.
- 9. Lastly add three of the Blooming Pearl embellishments to finish off.

- 2. After you color your floral image, add highlights using the Basic Black Stampin' Write marker in the flower centers and the leaves.
- 3. Rip around the flower image creating a rough edge all the way around.
- 4. Fold card base in half with burnish with a bone folder.
- 5. Adhere large piece of designer series paper to card front.
- 6. Add smaller piece at an angle on the right side of card.

- 6. Embellish with Neutral Matte dots and your card is complete!
